Butts his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County of Henry containing two hundred two and half acres in the Eighteenth District of said County which is known and distinguished in the plans of said district by number two (2) surveyed on the Eighteenth day of August 1831 and drawn by the said Nancy Casby (Widow). And I do by these presents hereby guarantee the right & title to the said district land to the said Felix C. Butts his heirs and assigns free from the claim of myself my heirs & assigns and all and every other persons or persons whatever. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this fourth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six Signed Sealed & attested

Kall and in the Eighteenth Henry District of said County known and distinguished in plans of said district by lot No (118) one hundred & eighty one originally Henry now D. Kall County in said District

To have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto him the said Allen Crowley his heirs and assigns together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto in any manner belonging to him and their heirs proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple. And the said William Towns for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the bargain premises unto the said Allen Crowley his heirs and assigns with warrant and forever defended the right and title thereof against them selves and against the claims of all other persons who may in anywise whereof the said William Towns hath hereunto set his hand and seal this day and year above written Signed Sealed & attested in presence of

 rights liberties and appurtenances thereof unto the said  
 said parcel of land belonging or in anywise appertaining  
 to the same To have and to hold said tract or parcel  
 of land unto the said Nancy H. Rice her heirs & assigns  
 to their own proper use benefit and behoof forever no less  
 simple and the said James M. McAlpin for himself his  
 heirs or assigns with warrant and force defend the  
 right and title of said land against himself and  
 against the claim of all other persons claiming  
 the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have
