Dekalb County<sup>3</sup> This Indenture made this the thirtieth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Joseph Willis of the County and State of Georgia of the one part & Joe Herring of the same place of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph Willis for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain sold and conveyed and doth by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Joe Herring his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land it being the half lot on the south side known by number (13) One hundred and fifty formerly in the 14 District of Henry now Dekalb Co. have and to have said said half lot of land unto him the said Joe Herring his heirs and assigns together with all and singular the rights numbers and appurtenances thereto to the same in any manner belonging to his or their own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and the said Joseph Willis for himself his heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Joe Herring his heirs and assigns will warrant and for ever defend the right & title thereof against themselves and against the claim of all other persons whatever in witness whereof the said Joseph Willis hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written signed John G. and delivered in presence of

conveyed & doth by these presents hath bargained sold & conveyed  
to the said William Lazzard his heirs & assigns a certain  
lot or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County  
of DeKalb known & distinguished as part of lot Number  
one hundred & seventy two in the fifteenth District of  
originally DeRuyt now DeKalb County beginning at the  
North east corner of said lot of land & running South  
along the line of said lot one hundred rod to a corner  
on said line and thence a due west course to a branch
