day of February in the year eighteen
hundred and forty four between William M. Johnson
of the one part and Joseph Weston both of the County
and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that
the said Wm M. Johnson for and in consideration of
the sum of four hundred dollars to him in hand paid
at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath this
day bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and convey to the said Joseph
Weston all that tract or parcel of land situated lying
and being in the Sixth the district of originally being
now DeKalb County Georgia and distinguished in the
plan of said district by the number forty one with
the exception of five acres on which the meeting
house now stands and the west half of a farm in forty
lots containing three hundred acres more or less to have
and to hold the said bargain premises to him the
said Joseph Weston his heirs and assigns forever in
fee simple and the said Wm M. Johnson for himself
his heirs and assigns the said bargain premises unto
the said Joseph Weston his heirs and assigns will
warrant and forever defend the right and title
against himself his heirs and assigns and against
the claim of all other persons whatsoever. In witness
