said Jeremiah Holloway for and in consideration of the sum
of fifteen hundred dollars to him in hand paid at and before the
signing and delivering of these presents the receipt of which is
sincerely acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed
and does by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto
the said William McEver his heirs and assigns all that tract or
parcel of Land Situate lying and being in said County in
cluding lot Number Eleven in the sixteenth district original
County now Schall County and part of lot Number Eighty Six in
the fifteenth district original County now Schall County known
and distinguished by the following lines corners and bounds begin
ing at the south corner of lot No ten in the sixteenth district as
aforesaid and the north west corner of said Number eleven and
running east on the line between said two lots to the south
east corner of lot No ten and north east corner of said No eleven
thence one south the line between said lot No eleven and lot No
twenty two to the south east corner of said lot No eleven and the
south west corner of No twenty two thence west the line bet
ween said lot No eleven and lot No twelve to the district line
of the said fifteenth district and cornering on divisions
line thence along the said district line between the fifteenth
and sixteenth districts to the corner of the said lot No
Eighty Six in the fifteenth thence west until it arrives on
the high water mark on the west bank of Sharpfinger
creek thence up the meanderings of said high water mark
on the western bank of said creek until it arrives at the
mouth of a branch running into said creek on the western
side of said creek thence up the meandering of said branch
until it arrives at the line between the said lot No Eighty
Six and the lot of land on which I B Badger now resides
thence east along the line of said lot No Eighty Six and

and ninety five dollars $4\frac{1}{2}$ cts on or before the twenty
fifth of December Eighteen hundred and forty three for value
received now for and in consideration of the sum of
five dollars by the said George Malcom to the said
William Armistead in hand paid the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing the
payment of the for said promissory note the said William
Armistead hath granted bargain and sold and doth by
these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said George
Malcom his heirs and assigns all that tract or lot of land

Newly Now De Kalb County known and distinguished in
the plan of said district by the number eighteen contain-
ing two hundred two and a half acres to have and to hold
said bargain premises to the said George Malcom heirs and
assigns to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof
forever and the said William Armistead for himself his heirs
executors and administrators the said bargained premises
unto the said George Malcom will warrant and forever
defend against the claim of himself and his heirs and assigns
the claim of himself and his heirs all other persons what-
ever provided nevertheless that the said William Armistead
his heirs executors and administrators shall and do
well truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said George
Malcom his heirs and assigns the aforementioned sum of
one hundred and ninety five dollars and $4\frac{1}{2}$ cts on the
