I must shortly depart this life deem it right &
proper both as respects my family & myself that I
should make a disposition of the property with which
a kind providence has blessed me so I have made
this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all others
heretofore made by me

Item I desire and direct that my Body be buried in
a decent and Christianlike manner suitable to my
circumstances and condition in life my Soul I trust
to rest with God who give it

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Nancy with whom I have lived thirty one years past
Lot of land No One hundred & Eighty five in the
Third District of the aforesaid County containing
fifty acres more or less To have & to hold as her own
right & property in person with the right
to dispose of as she may think proper by will
or deed I also give & bequeath to my Grand son
James W Crozier the East part of Said Lot of
land containing fifty acres more or less And
should he die before he arrives to age of Twenty
one years of age to return to his Mother Mary
Crozier I hereby constitute & appoint Reuben H
Pate my Executor &c, Signed Sealed & declared
& published by Brinkley Brown as his last
will & Testament in presence of the Subscribers
who subscribe our names hereto in the presence of
of Said testator at the Special & request of
