I may bear to me do Will Grant and bequeath after all
my Just debts is paid the following property to be equally
divided between. I share and I share viz one Thousand
acres of Land lying in the County of (Dooly 203) acres in
Randolph County and the following described negroes
Rufus, Peter, Henry, Lofton Cherry, bely, Leinas, Sam
Rhoda, Belinda, Terlong, and Samny five head horses
my entire stock of all kinds cattle Sheep and hogs
household and kitchen furniture farming utensils
One Ayr of Oxen and cart together with the of corn
cotton and potatoes and now growing on the plantation
Now I will that Charles W. Hayden be my
executor on my Estate.

I will that my wife and Children stay on my
plantation and for my Executors to sell such things to paying
debts as he thinks proper now if my wife does marry I will
that my property all be appraised and her draw her share
and also when my eldest child becomes of age I will the property
be appraised he draw his share and so on untill they all get
their share I will that my Children have a good English
Education out of my property I do hereby warrant and
defend the right title claim or claim from all persons
ever by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto
