

✓ Will of Irwin Bullock

Dooly County Will Bk 1847-1901

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State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen
Dooly County } 3

I Irwin Bullock of said State and county being of advanced age and knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it right and proper both as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me do therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.

1st Item; I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it as I hope for eternal salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ whose religion I have professed and as I humbly trust enjoyed for thirty five years.

2nd Item; I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without delay by my executors hereinafter appointed as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed in their rights especially as there is no necessity for delay.

3rd Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sadie with whom I have lived in the strictest quiet for forty eight years, one hundred acres of lot of land No 164 in the seventh district Dooly County (south east half of said lot) to have and to hold to her own proper use and benefit during her natural life or widow-hood after which time to be distributed among my children in the same manner and in the same proportion as the balance of my estate herein after mentioned.

4th Item; I give and bequeath to my beloved wife for and during her natural life or widow-hood (only) after which to be distributed in the same manner as the above mentioned land, my negro man Henry about thirty two years

age, my negro girl Ella about six years old. Also two mules, two cows and calves, two sows and pigs, Bacon, Corn, fodder, peas, fowls, wheat for the next year. Also two beds and furniture one set cups and saucers, one set plates one set chairs, one dining table, and such other crockery ware as she considers necessary for her use which is now in the house, Also sufficient kitchen utensils to serve her purpose, and also the buggy and harness which I now own.

5th Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah A. B. Oliver wife of William B. F. Oliver and her children free from the debts and liabilities of her present or future husband an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children.

6th Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Glenora B. Johnston wife of W^m B. Johnston and her children free from the debts and liabilities of her present or future husbands an equal and individual portion of my estate less three hundred dollars not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children. And I do hereby appoint W^m B. Johnston her husband her trustee.

7th Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Emeline S. Newbery wife of Isaac J. Newbery and her children free from the debts and liabilities of her present or future husbands an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children. And I do hereby appoint Isaac J. Newbery her husband her trustee.

8th Item: I give and bequeath to my daughter Virginia G. Waller wife of John G. Waller and her children free from the debts and liabilities of her present or future husbands an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children. And I do hereby appoint John G. Waller her husband her trustee.

9th Item: I give and bequeath to Sadysia P. Walters and her children free from the debts and liabilities of her present or future husbands an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children. And I do hereby appoint Sadysia P. Walters her mother her trustee.

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deceased an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children. In case either of the above mentioned, Ladyscia P. Waters and Daniel M. Waters should die intestate then the undivided portion above mentioned to return to my children and be disposed of as the balance of their portion of my estate.

10th Item: I give and bequeath to each of my sons to wit Charles, I. Bullock, Daniel, M. Bullock James R. Bullock and Joseph A. Bullock an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children.

11th Item: I give and bequeath to each of my daughters Florida, L. Blaylock and Victoria, F. Baskin, an equal and individual portion of my estate not otherwise disposed of with the balance of my children free from the debts or liabilities of their present or future husbands.

12th Item: I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Ladyscia Bullock Joseph A. Bullock and John G. Waller executors of this my last will and testament this September 24th 1864
