Dooly County, I James Buckelizer of the County
and State aforesaid being at this time in bad
Health but of a Sound and disposing Mind and
knowing that it is appointed unto all men to die do
make Publish and declare this to be my last Will and
Testament in Manner and form following

First it is my Will and desire that my last Will
Shall be paid With a little delay as possible and
for the purpose of doing so I hereby authorize my
Executor hereafter to be appointed to dispose of such
of my property as he may Consider Can best be
Spent. Second it is my Will and desire that each
my following named Daughter that is Harriet Martha
Eliza Buckelizer and my Slip daughter Ann and
Sister shall each of them have a Teacher's Bed.
My two daughters Mary Fulton and Amanda Stephens
Shall receive one Third it is my Will and desire that a
Cost Shall be raised annually on the plantations
until each of my following Sons that is James H.
John D and Thomas J Buckelizer and my Slip Sons
William C and Alexander Dickson shall have a home
when they severally arrive at the age of Twenty one
years Fourth it is my Will and desire that my property
be kept together until my youngest child by my present
wife Shall arrive at the age of Twenty one year when
it is my Will and desire that an Equal division
be made thereof to be placed among my following
named children that is Mary Fulton Amanda Stephens
James J John D Thomas J Harriet Martha E Eliza Buckelizer
Shall and shall alike

Fifth I hereby constitute and appoint my
friend G. H. Ford Executor to this
my last Will and Testament
