

✓ Will of James Sannage

Dooly County Will Bk, 1847-1901
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State of Georgia In the name of our Father
Dooly County I James Sannage of said State
of Georgia being of sound & disposing mind & taking
into consideration that at men must die do therefore
make this my last will & Testament. hereby revoking
and annulling all other Wills by me at any time heretofore
made

Item 1st I desire & direct that all my just be paid
by my Executor hereinafter named as soon as can be
done without manifest injury to my Estate after my
death

Item 2nd I hereby give & bequeath to my wife
Elizabeth Sannage for & during her natural life or
widowhood the following two Negroes to wit Sol a
man and Bill a woman, the said two Negroes at
her death or marriage to revert back to & become a part
of my Estate & to be sold & equally divided among all
my children according to the provisions & stipulations
hereinafter named. I also give unto my said wife
one good horse, two cows & calves & ten head of stock
hogs, and one years provision & two Beds & furniture
and Household & Kitchen furniture sufficient for
her comfort & convenience

Item 3rd It is further my will & desire that my
Executor hereinafter named do as soon as he can
consistently with the interest of my Estate purchase
a piece of land sufficient in quality & quantity as
a homestead for my said wife for her to make
an ample support on, and this to be expressly
in lieu of dower in my lands that I now own
or may be possessed of and at her death the
same to be sold & divided equally between all
my children according to the provisions & stipulations
hereinafter named

Item 5th It is my Will & desire that the residue of
 property after settling the legacies before mentioned in
 Item Second Third & fourth be sold & the proceeds thereof
 be equally divided between all my children & their
 issue alike under the provisions & stipulations
 hereinafter named

Item 6th I give & bequeath to my Son Leroy S.
 Sammage the one Eighth part of my Estate both
 real & personal always excepting the legacies bequeathed
 in Item Second Third & fourth

Item 7th I give & bequeath to my Son James M.
 Sammage the one Eighth part of my Estate both real
 & personal always excepting the legacies bequeathed in
 Item Second Third & fourth

Item 8th I give & bequeath to my Son William H.
 Sammage the one Eighth part both real & personal
 always excepting the legacies bequeathed in Item
 Second Third & fourth

Item 9th I give & bequeath to my Son George Sammage
 the one Eighth part of my Estate both real & personal
 in addition to the sum of Five hundred dollars
 bequeathed him in Item the fourth - always excepting
 the legacies bequeathed in Item Second & Third

Item 10th I give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy
 Core Wife of Thomas J. Core & her children by her
 present husband Thomas J. Core & her children
 by any future husband free from the disposition
 of her present husband or any future husband
 the one Eighth part of my Estate both real &
 personal of which I am possessed always excepting
 the bequests included in Item Seven Third & fourth
 to my said daughter Nancy Core & her said
 children

I hereby leave and my children

Item 11th I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Ann B. Hogsett wife of John P. Hogsett and her children or her present husband or any future husband the one eighth part of my estate both real & personal of which I may be possessed excepting the bequests contained in Item Second Third & fourth. The said one eighth part to be free from the disposition of her present husband John P. Hogsett or any future husband but to my said daughter & her said children forever and appoint John P. Hogsett Trustee for the property herein bequeathed to my daughter Sarah Ann B. Hogsett & her children.

Item 12th I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Bullington and her children by her present or any future husband the one eighth part of my estate both real & personal of which I may be possessed excepting the bequests contained in Item Second Third & fourth. The said one eighth part of my estate to be free from the disposition of her present husband Robert F. Bullington or any future husband but to my said daughter & her children forever and appoint Robert F. Bullington Trustee for the property herein bequeathed to my daughter & her children.

Item 13th I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Ann S. Sarrage and her children by any husband to whom she may be hereafter married free from the disposition of such husband but to remain to the benefit of her self and such children forever. The one eighth part of my estate both real and personal of which I may be possessed excepting the bequests contained in Item Second Third and fourth and I appoint James M. Sarrage Trustee for the property bequeathed to my said daughter and her children.

Item 14th I constitute and appoint my Brother
