

Will of John S. Wood

Dooly County Will Bk 1847-1901

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State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen,
Dooly County } I John S. Wood of said State and County
being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make
this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all
others heretofore made by me.

Item First, - I give and bequeath to my brother Andrew
Jackson Wood my Hous. Stock of Hogs and any other prop-
erty or choses in action of every description that I own or
possess after paying all my just debts without any delay.

Item Second - I hereby nominate and appoint my brother
in law Jonathan Taylor Executor to this my last Will
and Testament.

Signed Sealed published and declared to be my last Will
and Testament this 15th day of March 1862 in presence of
The unders in law Jonathan Taylor intimated & Andrew
Jackson Wood Stricken out before signing)

Will. Sworn to & subscribed before me in open
Court this 7th day of July 1862. S.
