

Will. of Noah Daniel

Dooly County, W. Va. 1847-1901
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State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen,
Dooly County } I Noah Daniel of said State
& County being in feeble health
and ill in body but of sound mind and
memory and knowing that it is appointed
once for all to die and depart this life deem
it right and proper both as regards myself
and family that I should make and dispose
of the property with which a kind & merciful
Providence has been pleased to bless me,
I therefore make and declare this to be my
last Will and testament, and desire that
my property should be disposed of in the
following manner to wit:

- Item 1st - I desire in the first place that all
my just debts be paid,
- Item 2nd - I give to my wife Eliza a bed
Bedstead & Furniture,
- Item 4th I give to my daughter Martha
one Bed, Bedstead and Furniture,
- Item 3rd I give to my daughter Mary
one Bed, Bedstead and Furniture,
- Item 6th I give to my son Jesse Thirty
dollars & my daughter Harriet also thirty dollars,
- Item 7th - I desire my corn and fodder
sold; and my Bacon & Lard sold for cash,
- Item 8th - I wish my arable land rented
and my negro girl hired ~~to do the work~~
of October next,

Item 9th I will that my horses & Wagon
Buggy, and farming tools be sold in a
short time, also my household & Kitchen
Furniture of every description,

Item 10th - I will that my Wheat cattle
and Hogs and manure of Cotton Seed and

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also my present crop of wheat & oats to be sold when ripe,

Item 11th - I Will That all my land and Negro be sold on the first Tuesday in October next and out of the proceeds of this sale I give to my wife Eliza one thousand dollars extra and the balance to be equally divided between her and my living children or their heirs,

Now reposing special trust & confidence in Henry Barton and William Barton I ordain them and appoint them my Executors to this my last Will and Testament this 9th day of January 1858
Noah Daniel

I desire my Executors that of the money I have in hand and arising out of the cash sales to furnish my family with necessities this 9th January 1858,

of the last Will and Testament of the
said Noah Daniel decd by the said
Noah Daniel and that they were request-
ed by the said Testator to witness the

time of signing said Will said Nott Daniel was of sound mind and disposing memory and that he made the same of his own free will and that they each subscribed the same in the presence of each other and William W. Keogse who also subscribed it as a witness in the presence of us and of the Testator.
