

Last Will and Testament of Mary D. Dougherty

Georgia I Mary D. Dougherty of Dougherty County State of Georgia single with the shewing & earnestness of life, and wishing as far as I am able as to my temporal affairs to set my hands and being of sound mind & memory do make & declare this my last Will & Testament in words following to wit:

Whereas in consideration of certain amount of money given by me to my husband and our lifetime as the proceeds of my Estate. Be agreed to relinquish entirely, but one third interest in my Estate at my death, as named and provided in my Marriage Contract, and also consent and assent, that I shall dispose of by Will, his several purchases to him viz. Henry & Rose. I propose to make disposition of the property which I consider as constituting my Estate and of my personal property as follows by Will.

1st I Will and bequeath to my husband a negro boy now about 20 years of age also my Horse and Carriage and our room furniture

2nd I Will and bequeath to my niece Mary B. Childers the following amount to wit: Rent, bathman and her children Julia, Arch, Martha, Emma & Lina and any children that may hereafter be born of her before my death, also Mary, Peggy and her children Louisa Emily, Jordan Caroline & any further issue of Peggy and her daughter just named, also Isaac, Lewis, Byron and Sara & Tamara, the above legacy subject to the payment of one Hundred dollars annually to sister Eliza D. Hunt during her lifetime. I also give to my niece Mary B. all my household and kitchen furniture not included in the bequest to my husband.

3rd To my niece Ellen B. Hunt and her husband and her body I will give bequeath the sum of \$1000 and her servant to wit: Bessie.

to her and their income. If my niece have no children the property is to be hers for life and to go at her death to any person or persons which she may designate by will deed of gift or any other legal form

I Will and bequeath to my step son Charles E. Mallory the following servants to wit, Henderson, Peter, Ben, Helly and her children Amelia and so and any further issue she may have. This legacy subject to the payment of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollar annually to my husband during his lifetime

I Will and bequeath to my step son Rollin D. Mallory the following servants to wit, Henry, Bennett, Tom and Mandy and any issue that Mandy may have before my death. I also sanction and confirm the gift that I made to said Rollin D. in my lifetime of a servant named Sophian the above legacy subject to the payment of one hundred and fifty dollar annually to my husband during his lifetime

I Will and bequeath to my niece Ellen C. Hunt the servants Tom & Nora

I Constitute and appoint my Husband C. E. Mallory my step son Charles E. Mallory & Virgil A. Childers as the Executors of this my last will and testament and I hereby revoke all other wills heretofore by me made

Codicil to the Above Will & Testament

I Mary D. M. Mallory do this day (May 8th 1857) reaffirm
all the items of the above will and Testament duly
Executed 25th January 1857 with the exception of the item
embracing the legacies made to my step son Charles E.
and Hollin D. Mallory and my niece Ellen G. Hunt
In Lieu of said items I will and Ordain as follows

1st I Will and bequeath to my step son Charles E. Mallory
the following servants with the natural increase of the
female servants to wit: Henderson, Ben. Hatty, Hannah
Jo (also Fred) this legacy subject to the payment
of one hundred and fifty dollars annually to
my husband during his life time

2^d I Will and bequeath to my step son Hollin D. Mallory
following servant to wit: Peter Henry Jones with
Sophia given in my life time and her increase
subject to the payment of one hundred and fifty
dollars (1850) annually to my husband during his
life time

3^d To my niece Ellen G. Hunt and the heirs of her
body I will and bequeath the following women
to wit: Bennett, Fanny, Nancy and Sara and her
increase. If my niece have no children the property
is to be hers her life time and to go at her death
any person or persons which she may designate
Will deed of gift or any other legal form
