 desires while in life. Do make and pub-
 lish this my last Will and Testament
 hereby revoking and annulling all other
 Wills and Testaments by me heretofore
 made.

Item 1st I desire and will that after my death,
 that my body be buried in a decent
 and becoming manner.

Item 2nd I will and desire that my Executor
 hereinafter named pay all my just
 debts out of my effects.

Item 3rd I will and bequeath to my beloved
 wife, J. S. McEwen the following land
 to wit: Lot of land number six hundred
 and seventy seven (677) seven hundred and
 eight (608) and seven hundred and nine
 (609) in the eighteenth district and Sec-
 ond Section of Originally Cherokee now
 Douglas County, Georgia containing One
 hundred and twenty (120) acres more
 or less, the same embracing the
 House and improvements where we
 now reside, for and during her
 natural life, and after her death the
 remainder to be equally divided bet-
 ween the legates hereinafter named,
 and I also will and desire that my
 said Executor pay to her my said
 wife the sum of three hundred doll-
 ars out of my effects, to be hers
 absolutely to use as she desires.

Item 4th I will and bequeath all of the remainder
 of my estate, after the above named
 legates are paid, to Louisa Phillips, J. S.
 McEwen, Alexander H. S. McEwen,
 Mary C. Bullard, and N. J. McEwen, the
 same to be equally divided, equally

between all of them share and share alike to be in fee simple forever. The same to be sold by my said Executor on such terms and in such manner as he may deem best, and the proceeds divided as above directed.

Item 5th I will and desire that my son W. F. McEwen be my Executor and he is hereby appointed such with full power and authority to carry out the above provisions, even without having this my will probated, if all of my legattees should so consent, and it is my desire that all interested in this my will shall so agree as to pay all expenses.
