I, J. H. Capps, of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills heretofore made by me.

1. I wish my executors as soon as possible after my death to pay my debts. If a sale is necessary I direct them to sell my personal property and I authorize them to sell at public or private sale leaving the same to their discretion.
2. I give to my beloved wife, Cordelia Capps all of my property both real and personal until my youngest child hereafter named arrives at the age of twenty one years.
3. It is my desire and so direct that after my youngest child to wit: Henry Brady arrives at the age of twenty one years that my executors hereinafter named divide the real estate equally among nine heirs or into nine shares, and I give to each of the following named one ninth of my real estate to be divided to wit:

My wife Cordelia Capps, and to my beloved children W. M. Capps, J. P. Capps, M. D. Capps, H. D. Capps, Lilla Bonar formerly Lilla Capps, May Fomby formerly May Capps, Eliza Bryant formerly Eliza Capps, and Pearl Capps one ninth each.

I direct my executors to divide all of my real estate and let each of the above named heirs at law draw for the same after dividing my real estate into nine shares.

4. I give and bequeath absolutely

to my beloved wife Cordelia Capps
all of my personal property
remaining at the time of the division
of the lands as specified in
item 3 of this my will. and I direct
my executors to sell the same
at either public or private sale
and turn the proceeds over to my
wife as aforesaid.

5. I do hereby appoint W. M. Capps and
B. A. Bomar executors of this my will
and relieve them from giving bond
and security.
