Item 2nd I direct that all my just debts be paid by
 my Executor hereinafter named and to that
 end that all debts due me may be expeditiously
 collected,

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to Joseph Phillips
 Son of Eligah Phillips my home place
 with all the stock, tools and everything
 on the place, will be his when I am
 departed this life,

Item 4th I give and bequeath to Joseph Phillips,
 Damar Phillips, and A. J. Hembree, my
 upper place Lot No 73. Equally divided bet-
 ween the three to have and to hold during
 their natural lives,

Item 5th I nominate and appoint Joseph Phillips
 my Executor of this my last will and testa-
