First I will that after my death my Executor

Second I will and bequeath to my beloved wife

whatever kind, that I may possess at my

by her during her lifetime. It is my pur-
pose and will that my said wife shall have
a life estate in all my property which I
may have at my death.

Third I will that at the death of my said wife,
that all the personal property that shall then
be in the possession of my said wife, and all
my real estate, shall be sold by my executor
and divided among my legal heirs in the
following manner: I will that my daughter
Eva Lattis shall have in addition to her
equal distributional share, three hundred
dollars provided at the time of the death of
wife, the said Eva is unmarried and
provided she remains with her mother
during her mother's life after my death.
This provision is made to compensate
her for the faithful care she has taken
of myself and her mother in our old age.
I will that after my executor shall pay
the above named three hundred dollars,
that he shall equally divide the money
arising from the sale of all the property
among the following named heirs Mrs. Cora
Davidson Vesta Wallman only son of deceased
daughter Alice P. Wallman, Vester E. Lattis,
Eva Lattis, Max Strawn and W. J. Lattis
except I will that in addition distrib-
utive share W. J. Lattis shall have one
mule to be selected by him, one hundred
and fifty dollars in money the same

to be paid out of my estate before any division is made as above directed.

Fourth I nominate and appoint R. B. Edwards of Douglasville Ga. my executor, and the executor of this my last Will and Testament and I direct that he sell my property herein mentioned, at public sale without an order for the same said sale to be advertised and sold at sheriff sales are made. I further direct that he make only a final return of his acts and doings relative to my estate and that he be not required to give bond except in the opinion of the ordinary the estate should require it.
