Last Will and Testament of George M. Daniell

memory, do make this my last will Testament

made by me.

cost over Fifty Dollars (\$50) each.

worth One Thousand Dollars after paying

worth the one Thousand Dollars, then I give
all of said estate to the said Joseph B. Daniell.

Item III. I wish all money left of my estate after
paying my debts and putting monuments
over the graves of my self and wife, and
paying the One Thousand Dollars to Joseph
B. Daniell as mentioned in Item 2 of this
will, I will share and share a like to the
following parties to-wit. Brother W. R. Daniell,
children H. J. Daniell, J. N. Daniell, George
Daniell, Brother J. B. Daniell's children to-wit
Vine Daniell, Carrie Daniell, Edie Daniell,
George Daniell, Orie Daniell, Berne Daniell,
Sister Susan Hamblen's children to-wit. Cole
Hamblen, Truman Hamblen, Isaac Daniell son
of Stephen Daniell and the children of Comzie
Daniell grand children of Joseph B. Daniell
to-wit. Lucy Daniell, Mildred Daniell, Mattie
Daniell and Comzie Daniell

Item IV. I hereby appoint H. J. Daniell executor of
this my last will.
