

Georgia, Douglas County.

I, Glenn O. Mozeley of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my last will and testament.

Item 1st. I give bequeath and devise to my wife Sarah Mozeley for and during her natural life the following property To wit: my present home place same being Eighty (80) Acres of land in the Eighteenth (18) Dist. and Second (2) Section of Douglas County Georgia together with the mill and all other machinery thereon. Also all of my personal property that I may possess at the time of my death.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my two youngest sons Baswell and Wells Mozeley the reversionary interest in my home place conveyed to my wife in Item 1st. of this will to be divided as follows. giving to my son Baswell Two Thirds of all the real estate on account of his affliction and to my son Wells one third. And the personal property heretofore given to my wife be equally divided between my two sons Baswell and Wells Mozeley at the death of their mother.

Item 3rd. I desire that the property given to my wife in Item 1st. of this will be in lieu of dower and years Support.

Item 4th. I having heretofore made provisions for all my children by my first wife and have made

advances to some of my children  
by my second wife it is my desire  
that my Executor hereafter to be  
named sell all my property not  
heretofore conveyed by this will  
and the proceeds be divided as  
follows: That all of my children  
by my second wife except Baswell  
and Wells be made equal and if  
there is any balance after making  
them equal the same be equally  
divided between all my children.

Item 5th:: I hereby constitute and  
appoint my sons Rollie and Will  
Mozley, Executors of this my last  
will and testament, and I do  
not desire that they be required  
to give bond.
