I, W. H. Hindman of

has blessed me I do make this my  
last will and testament hereby revoking  
all other wills heretofore made.

Item 1<sup>st</sup> - I commend my spirit to  
God who give feeling and assurance  
in a blessed immortality in the great  
world to come after death.

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> - I desire and direct that  
my executor hereinafter named proceed  
at once to pay all my just debts -  
as fast as convenient without injury  
to my said estate.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> - I will and bequeath unto  
my beloved wife Elizabeth A. Hindman  
all of my property - both real and  
personal and share in action of any  
kind for and during her natural life  
or widowhood. If she should marry  
again then I direct my executor  
to divide the property above mentioned  
equally. That is share and share alike  
between the said Elizabeth and all our  
children. I further direct that if my  
beloved wife remains single during her  
life then at her death all my  
property be divided equally that is  
share and share alike all our children  
then in life and descendants - if  
any are dead.

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I will that if any one of the  
distributees in this will shall by suit at  
law or other wise undertake to defeat  
or interfere with the disposition I have  
made in this will of the property or any

part of it, that he, she or they shall  
forfeit all interest in or to any part of  
said estate and my executor is not  
to give any part of the estate to such  
party or parties.

Item 5th. I hereby appoint my beloved  
friend J. G. Mason executor of this my  
last will and testament to carry  
out the terms of this will and that  
my said executor has the power to divide  
the property in kind or if he deems best  
to sell the same and divide the  
proceeds according to the division already  
mentioned in Item 3 of this will.
