I do hereby will that all my just debts be paid by my
executors as soon as practicable after my death
Item 3. Having advanced to my beloved wife Sarah
El Dammick the sum of eight hundred Dollars, and
returned to her all the property I ever received
by her. It is my will that the same two
hundred dollars out of my estate but to
claim, in the nature of a caveat or otherwise
the said sum of her own account
released all claims in writing. But I still
give her the two hundred dollars to be paid
by my executors after my death

Item 4. Give and bequeath to each of my seven
natural children, the children of my deceased
daughter Mary Johnson each the sum of
fifty Dollars and also to my two grand
children the children of my daughter Rachel
Johnson each fifty dollars To be paid them
immediately after my death which on account of
advances heretofore made is all they are to have
of my estate

Item 5th I will and direct that the residue of my estate after paying but the foregoing legacies and my debts be equally divided between my Two Daughters Elizabeth Edson & Lemuel Edson Thoro who shall alike

Item 6th Having already given and delivered to all my other children namely Arian A. Daniel Mary Johnson Rachel Johnson William A. Daniel Geo M Daniel Jeremiah B Daniel & J B Daniel & Susan Hamly each an equal share of my estate which they are already enjoying I have nothing more to give them

Item 7th To facilitate the settlement of my estate my executors are hereby authorized in their discretion to sell the property remaining in my estate at private or public sale without any order of Court or the usual advertising & to take charge of said property without any order or appointment

Item 8th I nominate & appoint my two sons Josiah B Daniel and George A Daniel my executors of this my last will and request that they act
