1st

I give bequeath and devise to my wife Sarah Dingler the
following property to wit: Seventy five acres of lot No. 184 said
land being on west side of said lot, it being in 3^d district
5th Section of said County, free from all charge or limitation
whatever to her own proper use benefit and behoof, also
all the stock of all description and all house hold
and kitchen furniture to hold the above property during her
natural life, and at the death of my wife Sarah Dingler

2nd

I give and bequeath and devise to my Daughter Sela, after
the death of my wife 37 1/2 acres of lot No. 184 it being on South
Side of said lot joining Our Jones to hold and have said land
during her natural life, and at her death said property to
go to her heirs if she has any, if she should not have
any heirs, then said property to go back to the estate.

3rd

I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sela Dingler after
the death of my wife, Sarah Dingler 37 1/4 acres of lot No. 184,
it being in N. W. Corner of said lot to have and to hold
said land during her natural life and after her death
said land to go to her heirs, provided she has
any, if and if she has no heirs then said land to go
back to my estate.

4th

I Except 1/4 of an acre for a burying ground lying
on the road back of the house joining Sarah Cornish.

5th

I give bequeath and devise to my Son Loyd Dingler
the following property to wit:
Twenty five acres of lot No 188 being in the S. W. Corner
of said lot Thirteen (13) acres of lot No. 195 - it being in
3rd district 5th Sect of said County, free from all
charge or limitation whatever, to his own proper use,
benefit and behoof, during his natural life, and at
the death of said Loyd Dingler, said property to go to
his heirs if he has any, if not that to go back to the
estate.

6th

I hereby constitute and appoint my friend C. M.
Jerkins Executor of this my last will and testament.
This Dec. the 28th 1876. Signed sealed and published,
by John D. Dingler as his last will and testament in
