while I have strength so to do make and publish
this my Last will and Testament hereby revoking all
wills by me at any time heretofore made and

First

I commit my soul to God who gave it and my body
I desire to be decently buried in some suitable
place and my worldly Estate I dispose of as follows

First I desire that my funeral expenses and my debts be
paid

Secondly

I bequeath and give to my beloved & lawful wife
Mary Entekin all my Estate both real and personal
during her natural life or widowhood

Thirdly

I desire that at the death of my beloved and lawful
wife Mary that my beloved sons Thos. M. Entekin
India S. Entekin John L. & Carterkin shall have
the following named lands being a part of my
Estate lot no 131 and 12 1/2 acres of lot no 151 being and
lying in original Campbell County now Douglas Co
Second Dist Equally Divided between them

Fourthly

I desire that the balance of my land as follows 66 1/2
acres of lot no 151 being the south part lying in the same
County and Dist before mentioned be sold and its proceeds
to be Equally Divided between them my two beloved Daughters
Mary A. Vassant Lammie E. Grogg so as to make them
equal with my sons and if the above named land is
not sufficient to do this I desire that my beloved sons as
of old shall make them equal and I bequeath and give
as aforesaid to my two beloved Daughters as aforesaid & their
body heirs

Fifthly

I bequeath my beloved & lawful wife Mary Entekin and my
beloved son Thos Entekin my Executors and now in the
face of God and in the presence of these witnesses
