I give, bequeath and devise to my son Thomas J. Farmer and to my Daughter Mrs M.L. Renfro, all of my personal property of every description, and all of my money that I may be possessed of at the time of my death, the same to be equally divided between them share and share alike;

Item 4th.

I hereby constitute and appoint my Son Thomas J Farmer, Executor of this my last will and testament.
