I give bequeath and devise to my nephew James Aubrey Black my home place consisting of dwelling and other buildings containing (40) Forty acres more or less in South west corner of land lot No (10) one hundred and one.

I desire and direct that \$100.00 One Hundred Dollars be deposited in the Douglasville Bank to be applied \$5.00 Five Dollars annually for the purpose of keeping in a suitable and appropriate condition my family

burying lot in Preys Mill Cemetery and that the executrix of this my will be a Trustee for the management of this fund.

I direct and desire that all the remainder of my property both real estate and personal property consisting of Five shares of stock in the Long Cotton Mills and Two shares of stock in the Douglasville Bank, both being located in Douglasville Ga, after my death be equally divided between the beneficiaries of this will to; wit; Rosine Lou Arnold and James Aubrey Black.

I hereby constitute and appoint my step daughter Rosine Lou Arnold Executrix of this my last will and testament.
