It is my will and desire that the house and lot where I now reside in Douglasville, Ga. containing one acre of land be sold either at public or private sale as my Executrix may deem best, and the proceeds divided according to the terms of the will made by my deceased husband that is to say Mrs. Maggie Boman and Mrs. Cora B. Hunter each to first receive the sum of Two hundred Dollars and the remainder to be divided as follows into four equal shares the heirs of Mrs. Helen McGowin to receive one share and Mrs. Maggie Boman or her heirs if she be dead to receive one share Mrs. Cora B. Hunter or her heirs if she be dead to receive one share and Annie Mary Wright to receive one share.

Item 4. I hereby appoint my daughter Cora B.
Hunter Executrix of this my last will
and testament.
