First

rights. Especially as there is no necessity for
delay.

3rd

I desire and direct and give to my Son
in Law, Enoch Hudson Henslee and his
wife Almata Henslee, my Daughter, my
home place on lot of Land No. 83 in the 2nd
District 5th Section of said County, also what
I own on lot of Land No. 84, and also what
I own on lot of Land No. 77, all in the 2nd
District 5th Section of said County. Except what
will be a enough to sell, to raise money to pay
my just debts by my Executor hereafter named
during my life for taking care of me and
tenting to me in my dotage, and if I should
become helpless and if they should have to be
at more trouble with me, than the rent of
said place is worth then at my death the
remainder of said estate, to be sold and first
my said Son in Law, and daughter Almata
for said additional expense, and then to
sell the remainder of my estate, and pay
those of my children which never had
anything. Rep to those, which I have given
something. Equal then divide the remain-
der equal between all of my children.
