Whose religion I have professed and as I humbly trust
enjoyed for forty years

Item 2 I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my Executors herein after named
as I am unwilling my creditors should be delayed
of their rights especially as there is no necessity delay

Item 3 I give and devise to my beloved wife Pamelia
Breed with whom I have lived in the strictest unity
asset some fifty years, all my real and personal
Estate with all the rights membership and appurtenances
thereto appertaining or belonging free of all charge
or limitation whatever to her own proper use
Benefit and behoof for ever

Item 4 at the death of my wife Pamelia Breed I desire
and direct that Curtis A. Chatham have and
keep, Stead and it be furnished with bed cloth-
ing also one black mare bolt now in my possession
also one trunk

Item 5 I desire and direct at the death of my wife that
Pamelia C. Chatham have all my home hold and
kitchen furniture with the exceptions of the furniture
named in the fourth Item also one Saddle mare
now in my possession

Item 6 I desire and direct at the death of my wife all
my real and personal Estate be equally divided
between Curtis A. and P. C. Chatham I constitute
and appoint my beloved wife Pamelia Breed
Executor my beloved Brother John Breed and my
friend A. Shiley Executor of this my last will
