

State of Georgia } Last Will and testament
Douglas County } of Richard White.

I, Richard White of said State and County being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament.

Item 1st. I direct my executor as soon as possible after my death to pay my debts, if any and for that purpose to use the proceeds of the crops for that year, and if the crops are not sufficient to pay the same I direct that the personal property or so much thereof as may be necessary be applied to the payment of debts including the payment of expenses of probating this Will.

Item 2nd. I give to my beloved wife Jennie White for and during her natural life all of my real estate which is hereinafter described and also I give to her absolutely all my personal property after paying debts and expenses as provided in Item 1st of this my Will.

Item 3rd. I give to my grand son James Bird forty acres of land to wit: Lot no. 891 of the 18th. district and 2nd. section of Douglas County Ga. and also 10 acres off of the each side of lot no. 892 in the 18th district and 2nd section of said County.

Item 4th. I give to my son R.A. White the thirty acres remaining of lot no. 892. in the 18th. district, and 2nd. section of said County and 30 acres of lot no. 919 in the 18th district and second section of said County.

Item 5th. I give to my son Morris White 30 acres off of the east side of the south half of lot no. 137 in the 18th. district and 5th section of said County, and I give the balance off said half lot of land consisting of $7\frac{1}{4}$ acres more or less to my daughter Minerva Reed.

Item 6th. I give to my daughter Minerva Reed 40 acres off of the south side of the

South half of lot No. 135 in the 1st district
and 5th section of said County.

I give to my grand son James Bridges
25 acres of said lot lying north of the land
willed to Minerva Reed.

I give to my son Morris White 25 acres of
said lot lying north of the land willed to
James Bridges.

I give to my son R.A. White the remaining
10 acres off of the north side of said lot lying
north of the land willed to Morris White.

Item 7th The land willed to my children and
grandson is not to become their property
until the death of my wife Jennie White
and they are not to have any control over the
same during her life time, and the land
willed to each is to be for the use of the
one to whom it is willed for and during their
natural lives with remainder over to their
children.

Item 8th I do hereby appoint R.A. White, Executor
of this my Will.
