I term second I give bequeath
and devise to my three children
who now reside with me viz:

Emerald L. Rickerson Saprona
B. Rickerson and Josephine
M. Rickerson for and during
the term of six years from
the date of my death the following
property to wit the north half of lot
of land No 356 three hundred and
fifty six in the 18th dist and second
section of Douglas County
containing twenty acres more or
less also one dark bay horse
mule named Rock and corn
and cover and fodder sufficient
to feed said mule until they
are made up provided
however if either one of the above
named children should marry
at any time during the six years
after my death then the interest
of said child in said property shall
cease and rest only in the child
remaining single at the expiration
of six years after my decease
said property to be sold and
equally divided between all
my children

Item third I desire that the remainder of my property be sold and equally divided between all my children
