

I, Samuel Turner of the State of Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory at the time of making and publishing this my last will and Testament, I do hereby give and devise all my estate of whatever nature, whereof I may die seized and possessed to wit:

Item 1st It is my will and desire that my body be decently buried, and that my funeral expenses be paid out of my estate.

Item 2nd I will and devise one half part of all my estate, of which I may die seized and possessed, to my dear Sister Lucinda Hopkins, wife of George H. Hopkins, and after her death to her children.

Item 3rd I will and devise the other half part of all my estate, of which I may die seized and possessed to the Heirs at Law of my beloved Brother Green B. Turner deceased, to share and share alike.

Item 4th My Brother Richard R. Turner would be remembered by me in my will, but that he has now a large estate of his own, and his condition in regard to health is of such peculiar nature that he could never enjoy any estate.

dollars and due the 25th of Dec. 1877-
which said obligation I now ~~cancel~~
cancel and will that he has no other
part of my estate.

Item 2nd

I will and bequeath the share that would
be coming to nephew G. R. Turner as heir
at Law of my brother Green B. Turner,
to ~~Arthur G. R. Turner as heir at Law~~
all the children of the said G. R. Turner
now in life, or hereafter born, share
and share alike, instead of G. R. Turner,
and believing that no one is better
qualified than the Father G. R. Turner
to act as agent for said children
with full power to feed, clothe and edu-
cate the said children out of said bequest
as his judgement may dictate
without making any returns of his
acts to any court.

and testament, parts attached in the pres-
