First. I desire that my body be buried
in a decent and pious manner.

Secondly. I desire and direct that all my
just debts be paid if I should leave
any unpaid by my wife W. C. she collecting
what may be owing to me and if she should
need any assistance before our son Jonathan
becomes of age call on Brother James or some
of my respectable neighbors.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to my dau-
ghter Marsha Boatright the place where
she now lives in the third district and
fifth section of Carroll originally now
Douglas County, fraction Lot Number 34
containing 134 one hundred and thirty
four acres more or less and Lot number
49 forty nine containing 20 1/2 acres.

Fourth. I Give to my wife and her two
children all of the balance of my property
whatever it may be whilst she may live.
it may be my son John Pennington to have
my place known as the Sabon Cove
place on the Chattahochee and Sweet-
water Creek in the first district of Carroll
originally now Douglas County. known
by the following parts of numbers 154, 155,
162, 163, 172, 167. Containing six hundred acres
more or less.

Fifth. my daughter to have my place known
as the Philliford place joining the Love place
on the Chattahochee the following numbers
and parts of numbers 162, 168, 170, 178, 155, 171, 178,
in first district and 5th section of Carroll
originally now Douglas County containing four
hundred acres more or less the Alexander
place to be equally divided between her
two children, unless their mother may
prefer to do it, numbers and parts of
numbers 163, 164, 165, 166. containing three
hundred acres more or less.

The land I have set apart for my
two minor children for my wife to
control for her benefit and her two
children and if one of them was to die
leaving no child its portion to go to the
other one. I hereby constitute and appoint
my wife Custody & Executrix of this my last
will and testament.

Witness, she notes I hold as agent for J. L.
Lassiter to be turned over to him when
he become of age.
