I L. J. White of said State and County, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make this my last will and testament, hereby revoking and annulling all others, by me heretofore made.

(1)

I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christianlike manner, suitable to my circumstances and condition in life.

(2)

I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without unnecessary delay, by my executor hereinafter named and appointed.

(3)

I desire and direct that my executor hereinafter named erect a monument over the grave of our daughter Winnie, now dead.

(4)

I give and bequeath to my wife Ella Lora White during her ^{natural} life all my real estate, and at her death I give and bequeath to my daughter "Claud" Land lots nos. 803, 804 and 851 in the 18 list, and 2nd section of Douglas County Ga. during her life and at her death to her bodily heirs if any, if she had no bodily heirs then to the bodily heirs of my son Hugh, if my son Hugh has no bodily heirs then to my nephew Lucius Clay. At the death of my wife Ella Lora White I give and bequeath to my son Hugh Land Lots nos. 805, 926, 886, + 852 in the 18 list and 2nd section of Douglas County, Ga. during his life, and at his death to his bodily heirs if any, if he has no bodily heirs to the bodily heirs of Claud my daughter, and if my daughter Claud has no bodily heirs to my nephew Lucius Clay I want my property to be kept in my family.

I desire that my debts if any be paid out of

my personal property, and direct that my Executrix sell what is necessary to pay these debts. I give the balance of my personal property to my wife Ella Llova White.

I hereby constitute and appoint my wife Ella Llova White the sole Executrix of this my last will and testament. I direct that she give no bond, nor be required to make returns.
