appoint my beloved son
James H. Abernethie to be
my executor and to all
of the foregoing request I
recommend his special
notice. And I do hereby
utterly disavow revoke and
disannul all and every other
former testament, will, legacies
bequests and executors by
me in any way before named
willed and bequeathed: ratifying
and confirming this and
no other, to be my last will
and testament
