of the Proceeds be equally divided between my

Tenthly - I will that so much of the property
herein above willed as is necessary to carry on my
farm for the present year to keep together until
the Crop can be made & disposed of.

Item 2nd — That portion of my Estate which is hereby
given to my Nieces is hereby given to them for
their sole & separate use & in no wise to be li-
able for any present or future debts which are or
may be contracted by their Husbands — and upon
the death of the said Nieces then their respective
portions is to be divided among their children
who may be in life at the death of their said mothers
to be held by them in absolutely full simple.

Item 3rd — I hereby limit the foregoing requests
with this condition, that should either of the Legatees
make any efforts to break this my will then they
shall not be intitled to any part whatever of my
Estate.

Item 4th — I hereby appoint my Nephew David W. Y.
Bryan and my relative Charles W. Stokes Executors
to this my Will & Testament. (Over)
