1839. In my last will and testament

- 1st I devise all my just debts to be paid
2nd I will that my grand Son Isaac Burne have
got in First Disposition Dr 25000 moneys and
on which his Stable price will be leaving Dr 25000
his guardian without being required to give him
and in case he should gather him without leaving
any bodily harm the Bank to revert back to me
grand children
- 3rd I will to my Daughter Mary & her issue all that part
of my lands lying North of the Landing Road Comm
Creek at the outlet on the West containing the lands
abut the South line running West until it comes
to the ditch near the river, and running South East
until it comes to the Spring near that corner to be
She being manager of the same during her natural
life then the heirs of her body
- 4th I will to my daughter Shebe A Harris her lifetime
then the heirs of her body the following in part
to wit, all that land lying South of

the Landing Road Commencing at the South line of
lot No 344 and running west until it comes to the
ditch near the Grindstone and South until it comes
to the Original Land Line known as the Burne
and Dyer Land line also will that my daughter
Shebe A Harris have a building lot off lot No 344
on the North side of the Grindstone Road Commencing
at the west line of said lot and extending one hundred
feet and forty yards a right the road East toward Shady
North far enough to contain six acres
- 5th I will to my Son John M Gilbert his life time
and then to the heirs of his body the following
property to wit All that portion of my lands
lying South of the Original Land line known
as the Grindstone Dyer land line to the
Garrison Land line Commencing at the ditch
or branch near the River and running East
joining the Alexander place on the South
line to land line of my House lot on the
west also five acres off of my House lot

including his House in which he now lives also
all that portion of lot No 344 between his house and
the landing ground

6th) I will to Susan Sermers my illegitimate child
her life time and then the sum of her body the
following justly to wit, All that portion of my lands
lying between the ditch over the River Pungo running
at the Mercier side on the south near the Spring
and extending southward to the place where
the Branch Stream joins the River also with all that
portion due to also a building lot off of Lot No 344
joining the building lot of my daughter Phoebe A
Harris's East land starting from the River and west
forty yards of the road East and running back
just enough to contain 60 acres.

7th) I will to my son William L Gilbert for life time
and then the sum of his body Lot of land No 300 in
the 5th Dist East Cor of land the former place in
part being on the borders of the former place and
I will the same to be included in other real Estate

8th) To wife Mary Gilbert all of that
portion of my House set of land on which I now
live except that portion that I have previously
disposed of also the balance of lot No 344 containing
fifty acres more or less that have not been disposed
of also my new wagon and teams

9th) I will to Susan Sermers my illegitimate child my
Rocky Mare and two Cows and Calves

10th) I will that my wife Mary Gilbert have her choice
of two Mules or Horses after Rocky is taken out and
the balance of Mule and Horses to be equally divided
between William L Gilbert John Whilbert Mary A Harris
and Phoebe A Higgins and also the balance of my Cows
after the two for Susan have been taken out to be
divided between my wife Mary Gilbert Whilbert L Gilbert
and my grand Sons and Kitchen furniture to my wife
Mary Gilbert except Susy Reed Strand and bedding
which I gave her And I further will that William
Whilbert Mary A Harris Phoebe A Harris and
Susan Sermers have not the power or authority
to sell or lease any portions of their lands

than a year at a time and that all other plunder
such as wagons, Carts, Steers and all other Supplies
plunder that is of no use to the plantation be sold
and the money to be divided between William H. Johnson
Mary Ann Stilke and Susy

11th) I will that my wife Mary A. Gilbert receive all money
coming to me and used as such by the same
necessity to defray the expenses of the present year
except once the balance to be used by herself and
husband for their Support and Cloathing etc
I will that my wife Mary A. Gilbert have the use
of the two Hill slaves and my Slave & his property
and one or Stilke & Harris jointed to have and
cultivate during her life than the little to be done in
directed above, I further will that if and one of my
children shall Gilbert, John H. Gilbert, Mary A. Stilke
