

Georgia, of Benjamin J. Wolf of the County of  
Early County, State aforesaid do make constatute and  
appoint this to her my last Will and Testa-  
ment in manner and form following:

First, I desire and direct that my Estate Real and Personal  
be kept together and worked and managed for the joint  
benefit of my Wife and children until my youngest  
child shall arrive at the age subject to the following  
conditions,

First. When any one of my children shall arrive at the legal  
age by Marriage or otherwise such child shall be au-  
thorized to demand and have their distributive share of  
my whole Estate Lands excepted assigned to them in  
the usual manner of distributing Estates and so on  
until the youngest child shall be of age.  
Then I desire and direct that the whole of my real  
Estate or lands, shall be sold and the proceeds  
equally divided between my wife of living and  
my children.

Second, I desire and direct and hereby especially  
declare my <sup>1839-1895</sup> Early County Wills  
of my Estate [www.georgiapioneers.com](http://www.georgiapioneers.com) shall or may be  
assigned to either of my daughters shall be  
so held by them for their own proper use and  
benefit free from any liability of any debts or  
contracts which their husbands may have at the time  
of their intermarriage or may thereafter contract,  
and should either of my daughters die leaving  
a child or children, I do direct that such  
portion of my Estate as may have been received  
by her shall be equally divided between them  
and my wife of living, and my remaining  
children subject to the like conditions as men-  
tioned above, for my daughters.

Lastly, I request my wife Mary Wolf and my son  
James H. Wade to act as my executors to carry  
into effect this my last Will and Testament  
and I hereby constitute and appoint them as  
such for that purpose.

In Testimony I have hereunto set my hand and  
and seal, this third (3) day of August in the year  
of our Lord Eighteen hundred and forty one (1861)

herein and affix my my last  
Will and Testament in manner and form as follows:  
Item 1. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Be  
linda Griffin lot of land Number one hundred &  
thirty in the 28th district of Early County on  
which I now reside with all the appurtenances  
thereto belonging, also a Negro man named  
Frank, ~~Adam~~<sup>Apostle</sup> a Negro man, Rachael a Negro  
woman, three Mules or Horses, such as she may  
select, Five Cows & Calves, six Pigs & Pigs, and  
all the Household and Kitchen Furniture  
allowing her to divide that with her own chil  
dren as she may see proper to have and  
to hold the above described or named property  
for her own proper use and benefit for and dur  
ing her natural life. After her death I direct  
that such property to be equally distributed  
between her children.
