State of Georgia I Mark Sanders of the County and State
afforsaid being of sound mind and memory But in
Public Health and Knowing the uncertainties of life
do make and ~~Testify~~ This my last Will and Testament

1st I constitute my friend Jefferson Hutchins, my sole
Executor to settle up the Claims which may be against
me legally and to collect all claims which I have
against others

2nd I wish the said Jefferson Hutchins to sell my boy
Henry to such Person or Persons as he the said boy
Henry may select for his Master or Masters

I wish the said Jefferson Hutchins to Purchase the
Girl Rose from the Monays which he may Collect from
the sale of Henry or the amount which may be due me
from others and for the said Hutchins to see that she
Rose is freed from ^{Early County Wills} himself or any Person
whatsoever,

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4th I wish and desire that the balance of my effects to be
Equally divided that is after Paying all of my Just Debts
and Paying for the Purchase of the Girl Rose between
my Two Friends the said Jefferson Hutchins and a
John Power

I am under many obligations to them for their attention
and kindness to me during my afflictions

5th I Charge the said Jefferson Hutchins to Carry out
Faithfully the foregoing Bequest
