County of Early State and County do make this my  
Last will and testament  
Now 1st I will and desire that all of my Estate both  
Real and personal in the State of Georgia including  
Land, negroes, Stock of all kinds, Money, notes  
and Credits shall all remain together and be worth  
in Common on my Plantation for me during my  
Wifes widowhood and Childrens minority, and a  
such Child arrives at the age of ten or more  
to or the said wife receive his or her full proportionate  
part of my personal Estate and regardless of my wife re-  
taining possession of my plantation in Early County during  
her widowhood until her death or during  
said plantation to be equally divided between all of  
my children since and after the death of my  
Wife there are many before my youngest Child  
being of age when I leave all of my property  
both real & personal to be equally divided between  
her and the other children alike.

Item 3rd I do hereby give to my Daughter  
Julia E. A. Alexander my plantation by her free  
and undisturbed use and control of any time  
so long as she may live for her sole  
use benefit and advantage and from out such  
possessio[n] or control of such plantation time I know  
as her daughter she having no children then  
Her Estate shall go to my wife sons & daughters  
Martin, C. Alexander and their heirs forever she  
may and shall be a Partner in life one half  
to each & stand and the other half to my wife  
the same shall and have alike

Item 4th I appoint my beloved wife Mrs. Anne  
Alexander of this my last will and testament  
during her widowhood to be the Morn again  
I appoint Arthur Hartshorn & Co Executor to  
wind up my Estate

 there belonging in fee simple in the 13th Dist  
 over my hush land Estate & further bequeath  
 to my loving wife all the property of what ever  
 description that she has at the time of my death  
 four Wilches Cow, one Mule & one pony  
 and two hundred Dollars worth of Stock & Horses  
 more or less as she may choose or two hundred Dollars  
 Cash money in lieu of provisions of necessaries  
 all of which is to be taken by my son George A.  
 his full share of my Estate both Real & personal  
 I will and direct that my Executor  
 hereafter named shall have full discretionary  
 power to sell all of my property both Real &
