

State of Georgia I Martin J. Alexander of the said
County of Early State and County do make this my
Last will and testament

Item 1st I will and desire that all of my Estate both
Real and personal in the State of Georgia including
Cane, Sugar, Stock of any kind Money, notes
and Credits shall all combine together and be worn
in Common on my Plantation for and during my
wifes widowhood and Childrens minority and a
male Child arrives at the age of twenty one or more
years he shall receive his or her full proportion
part of my personal Estate and Negroes. My wife receiv-
ing possession of my Plantation in Early County during
her life or widowhood and at her death or during
said Plantation to be equally divided between all of
my Children share and share alike then to my
Wife share and share before my youngest Child
becomes of age then I shall all of my property
both Real & personal to be equally divided between
her and all the Children share and share alike
Item 2nd I bequeath my property given to my Daughter
Katherine E. A. Alexander by her free
and voluntary gift and Control of my Hus-
band the said James but be for her separate
use benefit and nothing but from my free
liberty or Control of such property and I shall
in said Daughter the lands of Children there
her Estate shall go to my two sons Martin J. and
Alexander J. Alexander and their Heirs should she
survive me and as I do stand in life one half
to each of them and the other half to my said
two sons share and share alike

Early County Wills
1839-1895
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Item 3rd I do desire that all my Estate both
Real and personal as my personal property and
interest in Georgia as to its distribution keeping
it shall not be sold or divided until my youngest
Child becomes of age as aforesaid

Item 4th I appoint my beloved wife Mary Jane
Executor of this my last will and testament
during her widowhood should she Mary again
I appoint Anthony Hatcher & Co Executors to
wind up my Estate

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- 1st) I will and charge that my Executor hereinafter
named shall as soon as he can after my death
pay all of my just bills.
- 2nd) I will and bequeath to my beloved wife Francis
E. Winbury my two lots of land in the 13th Dist
of Miller County Georgia known as Gold Run, &
two hundred fifty two (262) three hundred and
together with all the improvements appurtenances
there to belonging in fee simple in & to her
clover in my Real Estate & further bequeath
to my said wife all the property & every dis-
position that she has at the time of our marriage
four miles corner my mile square my doghouse
and two hundred dollars worth of such goods
as she may choose or two hundred dollars
cash money in lieu of provisions of any kind
all of which is to be taken by my said wife at
her full share of my estate both Real & personal.
- 3rd) I will and direct that my Executor
hereinafter named shall have full discretion
power to sell all of my property both Real and
