 declare this to be my last Will and Testament that is
 to say First after all my lawful debts are paid
 and discharged I give and dispose of the Residue
 of my property as follows to wit I give and
 Bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Pinelopi Gooch
 with whom I am now living and to my daughter
 by her to wit Lucy Ann Gooch and my Son by her
 Joseph George Washington Gooch the land and
 Appurtenances on which I am now living situated
 lying and being in the twenty Eighth district of the
 County & State aforesaid being part of lot number one
 hundred & fifty six in said district and Bounded as
 follows to wit on the north & East By the Gauley
 Road West by the Corbett Lot and South by St J
 Cheshire Containing in all about eighteen acres
 Each of my Said Son & my wife to enjoy an
 Equal Interest in the same during their respective lives with
 proviso as to my Said wife in case she should marry
 again it is my will that she should in that case forfeit
 her interest in said Premises hereby conveyed and that
 her interest so forfeited should revert to my two said
 Children in Equal Shares it is my will that my said
 wife & Children should enjoy their said interest in said
 land without the Power of selling or disposing of the same
 until the youngest Child comes of age that said land
 shall not be sold by them or any other Person for them as
 Guardian or otherwise until the Majority of the youngest
 It is my will that my first wife Emily Jeffers formerly
 and from whom I have been separated several years
 should not take any part or interest in any Portion
 of my Estate real or Personal likewise I make constitute
 and appoint to be Executors of this my last will and testa-
 ment hereby Revoking all former Wills by me made in wit-
 ness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affix-
 ed my seal the nineteenth day of May in the year
 of our Lord one thousand
