Tenth I give to my daughter Eliza A. Powell and
 her husband George C. Gant One Hundred Dollars Cash as a
 remembrancer.

Eleventh I give to my Grand Daughter Martha E.
 Gant Five Hundred Dollars to be disposed
 by my Executors in the best manner they may advise
 for Special benefit unto the said Martha to have
 her service till the age of Twenty Years and
 then to be paid to the said Martha but should
 the said Martha die before the attains to the
 above Specified age otherwise without giving them in
 that event it is my will and desire that the
 foregoing above mentioned sum shall with all its
 profits and increase shall be given to her
 Granddaughter Martha the daughter of Peter W. Long Holmes
 as before mentioned and further more should the
 said Anna Gant die without issue then in

that Event I well and advise that the bequest above
mentioned shall with all the increase occurring expon-
esing descend to and be equally divided between my
two Grand Children Emmet Holmes and Susan
Holmes the heirs of my son John W Holmes deceased
I the 7th is my will and earnest desire that from
and after the 25th day of each Eighteen Hundred
and Thirty three my three Negroes namely Bill Lee
and Mahaly their daughter be hired out at public sale
to the highest bidder annually for one Year on such
terms as her Guardian may prescribe and
the proceeds of the Same shall be paid
to myself during my life and at my decease
to my Executor which sum is hereby known
and stated together with all other monies
the said Negroes above mentioned may, say
shall when it amounts to the sum of Fifteen Hun-
dred Dollars be sold or face Satisfaction by
myself my heirs Executors and assigns for the same
hereby witness before me and all monies in
sum p. a. 1839-1895 occurring by virtue of their
labor or otherwise as and when thereafter
to the best fit comfort and support of said
said Lee & a. the other as hereinafter and
the said Negroes when the payment of the afo-
re said sum of One Thousand four hundred Dollars shall
be except from sale in as soon as may my heirs
death. To my Son Henry Holmes no sum to I give and bequeath
monies that may be saved or considered by the heirs of the
said Negroes namely Bill Lee & Mahaly for one Year
is contemplated by the eighth section of this my last will
and Testament To the said Negroes and assign-
ees no yearly set apart the sum of one
hundred and forty Dollars with out of which
monies now due me which sum is in One Thousand
Hundred and fifty Dollars with interest - but before
terminated by the discharge and payment of the
sum due from my deceased Son John W Holmes
unto my sons late 1700 m. and this J. Holmes
is upon by a note made bill on the following
dates sum of One Thousand four hundred Dollars
and fifty Dollars borrowed money with him
from the 13th day of December last January 1837
