I Richard Pickle of the County of Early, and State of Georgia being of sound and disposing mind & memory, and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, while I have strength so to do, do make and publish this my last will and testament thereby, certifying all withal by me at my time herefore made,
And first I commend my soul to the God who gave it and my body I desire to be buried on the family burial Ground on my own premises and my earthly Estate I do here set forth as follows,

Second) I give & bequeath to my Son David G. Pickle, the sum of two hundred dollars to be paid out the Estate after my death.

Item 3rd) I give and bequeath unto my Son John G. Pickle the farm

on which he now lives consisting of Fifty acres of land, situated and

being in this County, Alabama, and forty acres lying in the same

County, and State.

Item 4th) I give & bequeath to my son Michael G. Pickle the farm on
which he now lives, embracing three lots of land, in the County of Miller
number of said lots, not now recollect, I also give unto him all the
property he now has in possession, belonging to me, consisting of Horses
that draw, Horses & Kitchen furniture.

Item 5th) I give and bequeath to my Son Shleton G. Pickle, my Bed
place, one Bedstead, Mattress &c, Two Boxes & Clothes,

valued at one hundred & fifty dollars, two Boxes & Clothes, one Bed &
Bedstead, Mattress & furniture.

Item 7th) I give & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy G. Pickle, one Horse
valued at one hundred & fifty dollars, two Boxes & Clothes, one Bed &
Bedstead, Mattress & furniture.

Item 8th) I also give and bequeath to my Son, Marshall G. Pickle lot
of land number nineteen in the 9th district of Early County,

Item 9th) I give and devise unto my Wife Elizabeth Pickle, the
two lots of land on which I now live, and on which my farm
is situated, being lots No's fourteen & twenty six in the Twenty
eighth district of Early County, & the rents issues & profits
thereof for during the time of her natural life, and during the time
she continues my widow, and from & after the death of my widow
or after she shall cease to be my widow, I give & bequeath
my the said lots of land number fourteen and twenty six
in the twenty eighth district of Early County jointly to my
sons Harris Pickle and Shleton G. Pickle and their heirs &
successors for ever.

Item 10th) I give and bequeath unto my said wife
Elizabeth Pickle the following named negroes my Servants
Jack, Eliza, Sarah, Isaac, Trade, George, Susan & Eliza

and their increase, and all other real and personal, residue of my Estate, both real and personal, and him by executors, guardians, and hequeathed to leave or to settle the said property and the issues and profits thereof during the term of the natural life, or during the lives of the surviving, my Widower, and from and after the decease of my said Wife or after she shall cease to be, my Widower, I give and bequeath my above named property and their increase and the residue of all of my property that may remain at the death of my Wife, with all my relation with Edwin & Th Pickle, David & Th Pickle, John D Pickle, Shiloh & Th Pickle, Michael & Th Pickle, Harris Pickle, Lucy J. Pickle, Nancy E. Pickle.

Item 11th. And I hereby command the guardianship of my Son Harris Pickle, until he shall attain the age of twenty one years, unto my Wife Elizabeth Pickle during her life of who shall so long continue my Widower. And so hereby declare that the expenses of the maintenance and education of my said son Harris Pickle, he shall attain the age aforesaid, shall be paid and borne by my said Wife by & out of the money, and estate given and bequeathed ^{Early County Wills} to her, my Wife.

Item 12th. I hereby command the guardianship of my Grandson, Nancy E. Pickle until she shall attain the age of twenty one years unto my said Wife during her life, & she shall continue by her self, and I hereby declare that the expenses of the maintenance and education of said grand son and all other necessary expenses which she shall remain unmarried shall be paid and borne by my said Wife, he and out of the money and estate given and bequeathed to her, my Wife.

Item 13th. And I do hereby command and appoint my Wife Elizabeth Pickle, David & Th Pickle and Shiloh & Th Pickle my executors & trustees of this my last will & Testament.

In witness whereof I the 1st day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five, and in the year of the birth of Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty five, I have signed this my last will of July 1895.

John D. Pickle, testator, signed and sealed this 1st day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five.
