disposition of this property as they please above divide the  
same as they may desire. Should my above Daughters  
mutually agree to sell the property or convey one of them  
major before selling them the other or assignaire Daughter  
is hereby authorized to sell & enjoy the proceeds of such  
sale under the limitations herein before prescribed.
