In the name of God Amen, I
the aforesaid being of advanced age, but of sound
mind and disposing memory, and anxious from
the common course of events that I must soon die,
do hereby make and publish that my last and
Will and Testament, hereby revoking all others by
me made by me,

1st Item I desire and direct that my body be
buried in the usual Christian manner, my soul I
well leave to rest with God who gave it.

2nd Item I desire and direct that all my debts
shall be paid by my executor or by my appointed

3rd Item I give and bequeath to my child George
Susan Anne Wood wife of William H. Wood two hundred
dollars in money.

4th Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah
Annanda Elizabeth Porter wife of Benjamin
Webster two hundred dollars in money.

5th Item I give and bequeath to my daughter
Sarah Elizabeth Parham one thousand dollars in
money, besides paying all of her bills that may come
this year for her maintenance or otherwise out of

my money, and one good leather-bound book
I leave to my wife, to bequeath to my son
and son-in-law, Richard John, Esq. and William Thomas
Panama. One hundred Dollars in money, that
money is to remain in the hands of my executors
if that my last will receives approval until
they are at twenty one years old, and my ex-
ecutors to pay them interest on the money from the date
of the execution of that my will.
I do then give and bequeath to my three
daughters, Mary, Jane, and Susan, named in that will my most
beloved personal property, except the articles mentioned in
them, to be equally divided among them,
viz. I do constitute and appoint Benjamin
Cochran my executor of that my last will and
to the same, and wish him to appropriate such
an amount of my effects as may be required
to enclose the shore of my late husband with a
brick wall, and also a sufficient amount to
reimburse him for the trouble he may
be in carrying out that my will. It is my
wish also that my executors should at his dis-
cretion pay any part of the principal of money
left my daughter Sarah, as a loan for the main-
tenance of said daughter.

And said interest not to be subject to levy or sale also I give
one feather bed and one Blanket.

2nd I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah L. Lee one negro
woman Nelly about sixteen years of age, and her child Charney
about three months of age one feather bed and furniture and
side board during her natural life and at her death to
her children on her body together her life estate in said
property not to be subject to levy or sale.
