money is to remain in the hands of my executors  
if that my last will receives approval until

of the execution of that my will.  
I do them I give and bequeath to my three  
daughters hereinafter named in that will my most  
beloved personal effects the articles mentioned in  
them to be equally divided among them  
viz. them I substitute and appoint Benjamin  
Cochran my executor of that my last will and  
to the said and wish him to appropriate such  
an amount of my effects as may be required  
to enclose the residue of my late husband's with a  
iron safe, and also a sufficient amount to  
reimburse him for the trouble he may  
be in carrying out that my will. It is my  
will also that my executors should at no dis  
cretion pay any part of the principal of money  
left my daughter Sarah Coburn for the main  
tenance of said daughter.

side board during her natural life and at her death to  
her children on her body together her life estate in said  
property not to be subject to levy or sale.
