It appearing to the court that heretofore
to wit at the full Term 1891 of said court
there came an affidavit before the court
of Alexander C. Harris of said county
the above states case that he then passed
an order admitting said will to probate
from which order said co-plaintiffs en-
tered an appeal to the Superior Court
of Early Co. and further appearing
to the court that at the April Term 1893
of the Superior Court of said county
there came an affidavit of said case
that the jury rendered the following
verdict to wit "That the jury find in
favor of the propriety of the will and
that the will is admitted to probate & that
the widow, co-plaintiffs, had no
which the matter of the will was in
possession at the time of his death
till her death & that J. P. Knight pay
her 1 bale of cotton for the year with
for the part he is cultivating this April
5-1893 (Ed Harris Foreman)
upon which the judge of the Superior
Court of said County rendered the follow-
ing judgment to wit:
"That upon it is con-
sidered by the court & adjudged
the parties assenting thereto that the
will in this case be admitted to probate
& that the widow have control of the
homestead of which Wm Knight and
the benefits thereof possessed at the
time of his death till her death & that J. P.
Knight pay her 1 bale of cotton for
this year with for the part he is
cultivating. this April 5-1893

in the support of my wife so long
as she lives. 3rd I give to my son
Eli Knight 100 acres of land off
of the east side of my home lot to
with Lot No 199 One Hundred & ninety
nine in the 38th District of said County
it being that part of the lot on which
he now lives. 4th I give to my son
J. F. Knight One Hundred acres of
land off of the west side of my
home lot to with Lot No 199 in the
38th Dist of said County it being
that part of said lot where he
now lives on 5th I give to my
grand children Joseph Wisher & Laura
Wisher the balance of said lot 6th
I direct it is my will that my per-
sonal property be sold after my wife's
death & the proceeds be applied to the
paying of her burial expenses & her
debts & bills during her last sickness
& the remainder be appropriated to
the payment of my debts. 7th I

herby appoint my son Eli N Knight &
 apt Knight my executors to carry out
 this my last will without hindrance give
 bond at to get any order of court to sell
 any of my property & they may sell the
 same at either private or public sale with
 them may seem best they are herby au-
 thorized from making any return of any
 worth of their estate & things & I bind
 herath fore given to my other children more
 than are equal share of my estate & my
 sons Eli N Knight have cared for
 me in my long afflictions & the please con-
 dition. In witness whereof I herby
 publish & declare this to be my last
 will & testament in presence of the
 witnesses who have signed same hereto
