myself that I should make a disposi-
tion of the property with which I am
blessed. I do there-
fore make this my last will & testament
First, I desire that my debt be paid as
soon as possible and so direct it and my
body be decently buried & direct it to be so.
I hereby make this as a first consideration
knowing that I owe & that it must be
paid sooner or later. Second, I give
& bequeath to my wife Martha Dammons
all my property both personal & real
during her life time and that it
shall remain until her death. After
her death it shall be divided between
my children John L. Dammons Mar-
tha Walker & the heirs of Adia Bran-
shaw & Emma Barr fixed equally with
this exception. My son John L. Dammons
is to & must have the homestead and
50 acres of land wherever he wants
it off of my lands & this to include
the houses & yards garden orchards
all the other conveniences that belong
to the homestead. This must be done be-
fore there is any division. Third - I
make my wife Martha Dammons
my executor manager of any
thing else that the law directs. So
that my business can go on just
as if I were present and to do all
that she deems proper for her and
my son John L. Dammons and fam-
ily comfort. Fourth - Now as
my son John L. Dammons has taken
to me in my old age I agree

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for him to have the use of the place
and no rents is to be charged against
him for said use. Fourth - Now I want
this understood that the part I have
willed to John L. Dammons is in trust
for his wife Mary L. Dammons
and shall never be made subject to
his debts and at their death to go to
his & her children. This January the
