and children I give all the tools goes to them &
The proceeds of my land goes to the support of
my children S. S. Lee my wife and children. The State
that is against G. S. Brown and the Statute is
to meet demands of my sister G. S. Lee against
G. S. Brown The remainder of said State
& land will go to my sister G. S. Lee my wife and
children all other property consisting of horses
(cons. Horses, Horses, Horses) Farming tools to be
to my sister S. S. Lee and Sarah S. McQuinn to be
equally divided between them I hereby appoint
my sister Thomas W. Lee and Sarah S. McQuinn
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
