I direct and qualify the above Provisions of the above item of this will to wit Paragraph (3) three to the extent only that my said Niece shall have a home on the place where I now live free of charge during the life of my Sisters aforesaid if she so desires I hereby constitute and appoint my said two Sisters Lucinda and Melvina allred the sole Executors of this my last will and Testament and I expressly confer upon them Power as such to administer my Estate in accordance with the Provisions of this will expressly freeing them from giving any Bond or making any returns to the Ordinary or to any other Court this 17th day of May A.D. 1911
