I John George Kiegle of the County of Chatham
in the State of Georgia / Planter / being very sick
and weak in body but of a perfect mind and free

memory thank God give unto God / Allowing unto him
the disposal of my Body and Allowing that
this will be for all my goods and estate / I do make
and ordain this my last Will in full knowledge that
I am perfectly and sound of all my senses and
my soul into the hands of Almighty God that
gave it me, and my Body I recommend to the

care of Almighty God that gave it me and
may to be buried in decent Christian Burial
at the discretion of my Executors: Nothing doubting
but as touching the same again by the Wholly I do
of God and as touching such worldly Estate I do
with it have blessed God to bless me in this life /
give, receive and dispose of the same in the follow-
ing manner and form Here:
That it is my Will and desire that all my executors
shall be a funeral expenses shall be paid from:
I do hereby and do hereby bequeath and do hereby bequeath

Secondly, I give and bequeath to my beloved son Emanuel Ziegler and to his Heirs and Assigns forever Fifty acres of Land whereon his dwelling house stands joining lands he purchased of Kitch and being a half part or moiety of a one hundred acre Tract, and a part of another Tract, say it being a part of three Different Surveys out of which three Surveys he is to have Fifty acres and no more nor any thing else out of my Estate.

Thirdly, I give and bequeath unto my other beloved son David Ziegler and to his Heirs and Assigns forever Two hundred acres of Land on the Second bridge Branch being part of three different surveys but the said David is hereby bound to be obedient to his father and Mother during their Natural Life.

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Anna Catharina all the rest and residue of my real and personal Estate Household Furniture, Kitchen Utensils and Plantation Tools Cattle Hogs and Horses during her Natural Life to Live out of the same to use and maintain herself out of the same, but after her decease it shall be equally distributed amongst my Children whatever is left except my said Son Emanuel shall not have any share more than what is first willed to him say Fifty acres of Land as aforesaid out of three several Surveys.

Fifthly and Lastly I constitute make and appoint my well beloved wife Anna Catharina Ziegler the Sole Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby disallow, revoke and Disannul all former and other wills by me in anywise made or Willed Ratifying and allowing this and no other to be my last will and Testament.
